
We know that building a brighter future for LGBTQ Jews and our loved ones takes courage. That’s why we are deeply grateful to have you by our side.

A New Generation of LGBTQ Jewish Leaders

Danie is a 19-year-old Jewish lesbian from South Carolina. Willow is an 18-year-old trans Jew from Washington State. Dotan is a 21-year-old gay Jew from Minnesota. In 2019, all three of them met at one of Keshet's Shabbat retreats — in Hebrew, Shabbatonim — where LGBTQ and ally Jewish teens and young adults are able to find their place and their voice as emerging Jewish leaders. Now, these extraordinary young people are becoming leaders in their own Jewish and LGBTQ communities. Danie is President of Hillel at their college. Willow is the incoming president of their college's trans student organization. And Dotan is a leader in the Wesleyan Jewish

Community as well as a counselor at Camp Ramah in Wisconsin, where he has been creating programming for LGBTQ campers and staff. Together, they are building a better world for all of us.

In 2019, Keshet hosted six gatherings in Pennsylvania, Northern California, Southern California, Massachusetts, Georgia, and Wisconsin for LGBTQ and ally teens and young adults to learn, grow, and nourish their Jewish identities together. Keshet also engaged LGBTQ Jewish teens through programs, conferences, and workshops across the United States to build more affirming and embracing Jewish communities for LGBTQ teens and their families.



“As a freshman in high school, I felt really disconnected from my Jewish identity. I didn’t believe that I could be both Jewish and lesbian. Then I found Keshet. Because of my experiences at Keshet’s Shabbatonim, I decided to start a Gay-Straight Alliance at my high school. Now, several years later, I’m the President of Hillel at my college. Everywhere I go, I strive to make the world as safe of a place as Keshet feels for me.”

A Home for LGBTQ Jewish Families

Growing up in the former Soviet Union, Leona Bessonova had very few opportunities to explore Jewish life. After her family immigrated to the United States in 1991, she didn't always feel embraced by American Jews. But when Leona and her wife became parents to their son Judah, they wanted to nurture his Jewish identity. They struggled to find a community in Massachusetts that felt right for them — especially as an interracial, intercultural two-mom family with Russian and Brazilian roots. Then they found Keshet.

In 2019, Keshet offered Massachusetts LGBTQ Jewish families with young children the opportunity to celebrate Jewish holidays, build community, and affirm their Jewish identities in a relaxed, accessible, and inviting environment. Whether celebrating Havdalah, gathering for “Latkes and Legos,” or offering family-friendly picnics during Pride weekend, Keshet is enabling LGBTQ Jewish families in Massachusetts to connect with each other and lead joyous Jewish lives.

Fostering LGBTQ Equality in Jewish Institutions

When Rachel Zaback moved to Michigan, she was eager to plug into the Jewish community, but wasn't sure how. As a trans woman, she wanted to find a synagogue that would affirm her identity and demonstrate an ongoing commitment to LGBTQ inclusion. When Rachel learned that Congregation T'chiyah, a Reconstructionist synagogue in Metro Detroit, was participating in Keshet's Leadership Project, she was intrigued. For many Jewish institutions that participate in Keshet's Leadership Project, making visible and specific changes to language, signage, and written materials is a first step to being inclusive and affirming of LGBTQ Jews. Before walking through the doors of T'chiyah, Rachel visited the synagogue's website and was pleased to see Keshet's "Trans Jews Belong Here" sticker prominently displayed on the homepage. She knew right away that T'chiyah would become her Jewish home — and it has.

Congregation T'chiyah is one of more than 300 institutions that Keshet trained and supported in 2019. Rabbis, educators, and other leaders at synagogues, Jewish day schools, JCCs, youth movements, summer camps, and community institutions across the United States partner with Keshet to ensure that LGBTQ Jews are fully respected and affirmed. Through Keshet's Leadership Project — a multi-service year-long program that convenes, trains, and supports leaders of Jewish institutions to become more inclusive of LGBTQ individuals and families — Jewish leaders gain the tools they need to embrace LGBTQ Jews from all walks of life.

In 2019, Keshet also established Leadership Project partnerships with United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism (USCJ), Jewish Community Center Association (JCCA), Foundation for Jewish Camp, and the Network of Jewish Human Service Agencies (NJHSA).

Advocating for LGBTQ Rights in Florida

In January 2019, the Governor of Florida issued an executive order that would allow Florida employers to discriminate against state employees on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity. Alarmed by how this order would threaten the basic rights of LGBTQ Floridians, Keshet launched a campaign to mobilize Jews in Florida to support the passage of the Florida Competitive Workforce Act — proposed legislation that would prohibit discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity in employment, housing, and public accommodations. Working with Equality Florida, Keshet rallied Jewish institutions in South Florida to safeguard the rights and dignity of LGBTQ Floridians. Local

partners included ADL Florida, Broward County Jewish Federation, Dave and Mary Alper Jewish Community Center, Greater Miami Jewish Federation, Jewish Community Services of South Florida, NCJW Florida, Repair the World Miami, Religious Action Center of Reform Judaism (RAC) and the RAC FL, The Tribe, and University of Miami Hillel. Although the legislation did not pass in the 2019-2020 legislative session, our efforts significantly strengthened the foundation for LGBTQ equality in Florida Jewish communities. The work will continue and the Jewish community will be ready.

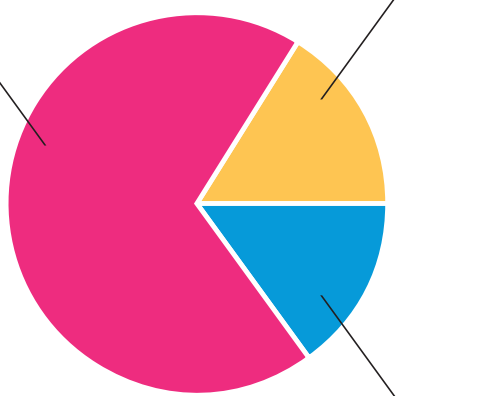

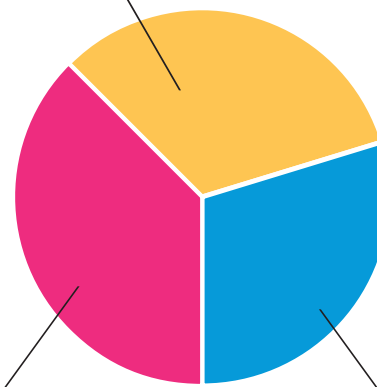

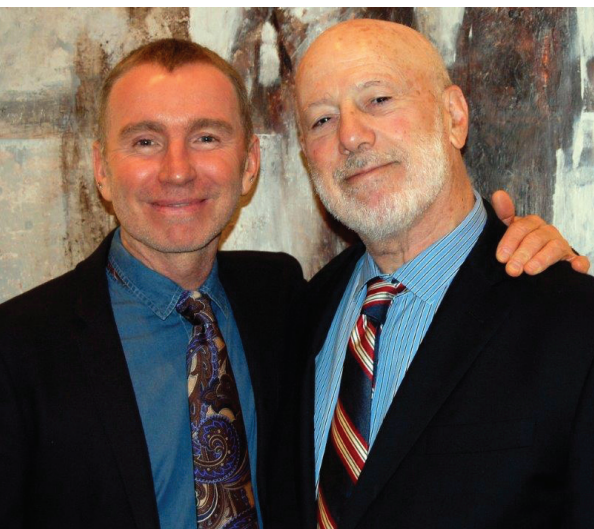
